VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

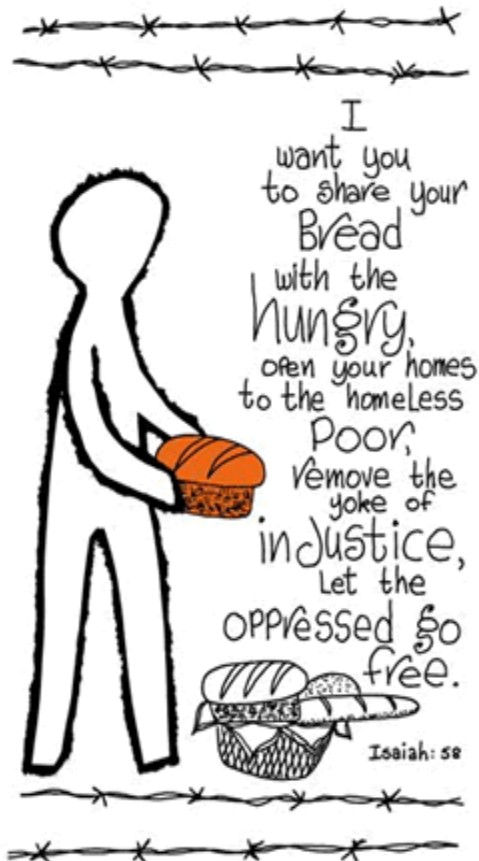
